Bastwick Street, London

Brief

Bastwick Street was completed for the Institute of Structural Engineers to act as their International HQ in London.

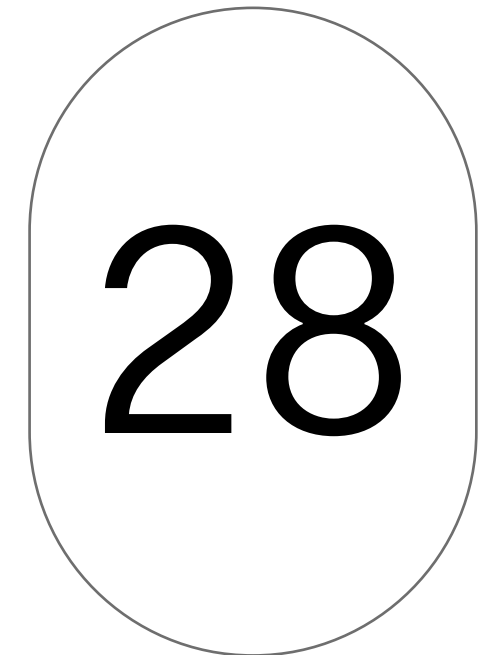
Project info

From strip out to floating staircase, auditorium and a façade overhaul.

The works were completed in two phases. The initial enabling works included the full strip out of the property back to its shell and core, and strengthening of the structure, including the use of carbon fibre strips to the slab. Phase two works consisted of the fit out of the office areas, formation of a new reception area along with a meeting room, and an auditorium.

A structural concrete wall was constructed within the main entrance atrium acting as the main feature for the space. This statement wall also provided support for the new floating staircase from ground to first floor.
