Our works at the prestigious King's College School involved the formation of a new main entrance to this historic listed building set in the heart of Wimbledon.

Project info

Updated school gates for the historic King's College.

The existing ground floor space was reconfigured including some careful structural alterations to form the new entrance and reception. Alterations were carried out to the mechanical and electrical services alterations, including replacement of existing boiler plant and installation of new platform lift.

Externally our works consisted of repairs to the external façade, new paving, boundary walls, iron railings and gates.
